






# **Our University**



# Sports and Comprehensive Training

### Sustainable Campus FEN

# Entrepreneurship and Social Commitment

The University Social Responsibility unit seeks to promote a **sustainable** and **socially** responsible culture by coordinating **curricular** and **extracurricular** actions that establish a two-way connection between the **faculty** and the **community**. These efforts are carried out through **three** fundamental areas:

- **Community-Engaged Learning** is an educational approach that aims to generate meaningful learning experiences for students. It does so by creating academic spaces that enable students to interact with their environment, linking their academic disciplines with current issues and challenges in real-world contexts.
- **Support for small businesses** involves providing tools and business management knowledge from the Faculty to the entrepreneurial community. This is done through informational sessions, training opportunities, and networking events.
- **EmprendeFEN,** FEN's impact entrepreneurship program, fosters the development of ideas and entrepreneurial ventures among students through both curricular and extracurricular training activities, ecosystem engagement, mentoring, and dissemination.

Starting from 2009, students from FEN UChile have been offering guidance to **over 1,500 businesses** and **organizations** spanning various sectors, involving **more than 9,000 students in advisory services**.
